



Getting from Vilnius Airport to Town	<p>Vilnius International Airport (Tarptautinis Vilniaus oro uostas) is situated approximately 5km south of the city center.</p> <p><u>Connection by taxi</u></p> <p>Vilnius Airport approved taxi cabs are ranked just in front of the arrivals terminal. All taxi cabs accept cash and credit cards. For the official information on the service rates and other modalities, please consult the website. In general, getting to the city center should cost ~ €15. Bolt and Uber are available in Vilnius as well, you can use this transportation services via apps.</p> <p><u>Connection by bus</u></p> <p>Direct buses run from/to Vilnius Airport to the Town Center. The bus stop at the Airport is to the left of the taxi stand and timetables are posted at the stop. Buy a ticket onboard from the driver for €1. Express rapid bus N°3G to Lukiškių Aikštė (City Center), Juozo Tumo-Vaižganto stop. Website of Vilnius Public Transportation System provides information of bus itineraries, timetables and possibility to plan your trip.</p>

<p>Registration</p>	<p>Registration of participants of the training will take place on 22nd October 2024, Wednesday 09:00 – 09:15 am, at the premises of the training.</p>
<p>Lunches, Dinner and Sightseeing tour in Vilnius</p>	<p>Please note that 2 lunches (on 22-23rd October 2024), one dinner (on 22 October 2024) and a Sightseeing tour in Vilnius is covered by the training fee.</p> <p>Detailed information will be sent to registered participants and the trainers will accompany the participants.</p>
<p>Travel and accommodation</p>	<p>Please note that the training fee doesn't include travel and accommodation expenses and you will be responsible for arranging it yourself. In case needed any support – please contact us training@cpva.lt.</p>
<p>Climate</p>	<p>The average temperature in Vilnius in October varies from 6 to 13 degrees.</p>
<p>Time Zone</p>	<p>Local time is EEST (Eastern European Summer Time) GMT +3 hours.</p>
<p>Electricity Supply</p>	<p>Electric appliances must have European plugs, (i.e. round-tipped, two-pinned).</p>
<p>Currency, Banking, Credit Cards and ATMs</p>	<p>The official currency is Euro. Cash machines (ATMs) are available throughout the city, accepting major credit and bank cards, and instructions are often available in English.</p>
<p>International Dialing Code</p>	<p>The country code for Lithuania is 370. To make an international phone call, you will need to dial 00 + country code + phone number.</p>
